



## TRAFFIC & PARKING PLANS FOR FALL TEMPE FESTIVAL OF THE ARTS

### **STREET CLOSURES SCHEDULE:**

The following streets will close on **Thursday, December 1<sup>st</sup>:**

Approximately 6:00 p.m. Closures (Peripheral Streets) -

- 7<sup>th</sup> Street, from Myrtle Avenue to Maple Avenue.
- 6<sup>th</sup> Street, from Myrtle Avenue to the Centerpoint Surface Parking Lot entrance, east of Ash.
- 4<sup>th</sup> Street, from Mill Avenue to Maple Avenue
- 5<sup>th</sup> Street, from Myrtle Avenue to Ash Avenue
- Maple Avenue, from 4<sup>th</sup> Street to 7<sup>th</sup> Street

Approximately 8:00 p.m. Closures –

- Mill Avenue, from University Drive to 3<sup>rd</sup> Street

All Streets should re-open by 7:00 a.m. on Monday, December 5<sup>th</sup>.

### **PARKING VALIDATIONS:**

Mill Avenue District business parking validations **are not accepted on event days.**

### **DELIVERIES FOR MILL AVENUE DISTRICT BUSINESSES:**

- We permit delivery entry **ONLY** at 5<sup>th</sup> and Ash (the west end of 5<sup>th</sup> Street). No deliveries will be allowed to enter from the East on 5<sup>th</sup> Street, the North or South on Mill Avenue. Deliveries will be permitted throughout the night beginning at approximately 11 p.m. on Thursday, December 1<sup>st</sup>; and, 9 p.m. on Friday, December 2<sup>nd</sup>; Saturday, December 3<sup>rd</sup>; and Sunday, December 4<sup>th</sup>.
- **All trucks must vacate the event area BEFORE 9:00 a.m. each day.**
- Should your deliveries not arrive before 9:00 a.m., please contact DTC Operations Hotline at (480) 894-1800 and we will determine the alternate load-in options available so that delivery can be accommodated.

- **In no event will deliveries be allowed after 10:00 a.m. on any day of the festival** except for U.S. Post Office deliveries which may require special arrangements.

### **PARKING FOR MILL AVENUE DISTRICT EMPLOYEES:**

Many employees have monthly parking permits which are color coded (see references below). In general, all employees should allow additional time to park during the event. Downtown Tempe Community, Inc., who produces the event and also manages parking in many of the downtown Tempe locations, will work with employees to meet their parking needs reasonably; however, it is the responsibility of all employees to make sure that they have secured their own parking permits.

Employees without valid parking permits, or employees who provide their own daily parking arrangements, will be required to park in paid public parking spots throughout Mill Avenue District.

- The Centerpoint Surface Lot will be open for PUBLIC PARKING. Employees will be able to utilize the lot.
- On Street Parking and small off street lots within the event perimeter will close at 5:00pm on Thursday, December 1<sup>st</sup>. All on-street parking on Mill Avenue will close at 7:00 p.m.
- METRO light rail provides free parking at 8 Valley Park and Ride so you can ride the train directly to the 3<sup>rd</sup> & Mill festival entrance.   - 19<sup>th</sup> Avenue/Montebello Avenue – 794 spaces
  - 19<sup>th</sup> Avenue/Camelback Road – 410 spaces
  - Central Avenue/Camelback Road – 135 spaces
  - 38<sup>th</sup> Street/Washington Street – 189 spaces
  - Dorsey Lane/Apache Boulevard – 190 spaces
  - McClintock Road/Apache Boulevard – 300 spaces
  - Price Freeway/Apache Boulevard – 693 spaces
  - Sycamore Street/Main Street – 802 spaces
- We will attempt to provide parking for all employees in their usual locations or alternate locations based on the following schedule:
  1. **Employees with Centerpoint Permits** – Spaces will be reserved in the Centerpoint Lot for employees holding a valid Centerpoint permit. These spaces may be accessed by entering onto 6<sup>th</sup> Street from Ash. There will be no overflow parking at 5<sup>th</sup> & Farmer Lot North and any overflow parking for employees will be routed to the City Hall Parking Garage at 5<sup>th</sup> & Forest. You must show your valid Centerpoint Permit to gain access to this location.
  2. **Employees with Hayden Square Garage passes** – Will be permitted to park in the garage on a space available basis.

3. **Employees with Hayden Square West Lot passes** – Will be permitted to park in the lot on a space available basis.
4. **Employees with Brickyard Garage passes** – Will be permitted to park in the garage.

If you're regular parking area is not listed above, and you feel your parking may be closed or affected, please contact the DTC Parking Operations Hotline at (480) 894-1800 to make parking arrangements. Please do so before Thursday, December 1<sup>st</sup>, as no parking arrangements can be made after that date.

In general, please allow additional time to find a place to park, and get to work. We will do everything we can to meet your parking needs but it is still up to you to see that you have the necessary permits.

### **PUBLIC PARKING FOR CLIENTS AND CUSTOMERS:**

- **Public Parking at the Festival:** There is paid parking available surrounding the Festival, and none within the actual venue itself. Since many garages and lots are privately owned, there is a charge that usually is about \$10, but may be different at each location. Look for parking along Rio Salado Parkway, University, Ash, and College. For specific parking locations in the Mill Avenue District, visit <http://www.millavenue.com/transportation>.
- **Accessible Parking at the Festival:** The Tempe Festival of the Arts does not offer a wheelchair concession.
- For accessible parking, the City of Tempe Municipal Garage at 5<sup>th</sup> & Forest offers FREE disabled access parking Friday, Saturday, and Sunday.
- The US Airways Garage, located on Ash just south of Rio Salado Blvd. offers FREE disabled access parking only on Saturday and Sunday.
- All other lots and garages offer paid disabled access parking.
- There is no parking inside the event perimeter. All available on-street parking throughout the Mill Avenue District is FREE to cars displaying required current disabled access license plates or placards.
- Dedicated accessible parking meters will be reserved along Ash Street between 3<sup>rd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> Street, on 5<sup>th</sup> Street east of Mill and on 7<sup>th</sup> Street east of Mill, adjacent to the Festival venue. As always, on-street parking is free for vehicles displaying required current disabled access license plates or placards.
- METRO light rail provides free parking at 8 Valley Park and Ride so you can ride the train directly to the 3<sup>rd</sup> & Mill festival entrance. For details see [http://www.valleymetro.org/how to Ride/lr park and Ride/](http://www.valleymetro.org/how_to Ride/lr_park_and Ride/).
